Dear Friend of Cedar Creek.

We're at a critical moment, and we need your help.

The proposed 13.2-acre private ski lake would pump 35,000,000 to 50,000,000 gallons to fill in the first 9 months. Then, 50,000-90,000 gallons from Cedar Creek and the Town of Cedar Creek aquifer every single day.

The City of Cedarburg's own engineer confirmed that during low-flow periods, this extraction will exceed the creek's natural flow rates. **That's more water pumped out than the creek produces.**

Plus, they have NO PERMITS and NO TOWN OR DNR OVERSIGHT, because they have designed this plan to avoid it!

What happens when the creek runs dry? Fish die. Eagles lose their hunting grounds. Your well could fail and require a new deeper well that will cost up to \$50,000.


Cedar Creek Park & Covered Bridge Park,, where our families gather for concerts, weddings and festivals could lose the water that makes our parks special.

This project, and projects like it, will impact Cedar Creek, the Milwaukee River and Lake Michigan.

Here is the Gauthier plan on the left. This is the size of almost 10 football fields right next to Covered Bridge Park, the original Covered Bridge Farm, and countless neighbors who live along this 9 parcel area.

On the right is the standard development plan for a ski lake like this. The Gauthiers would not comment on their future development plans at the Town Board Meeting.

But they did say, they do not plan to live on the property.
